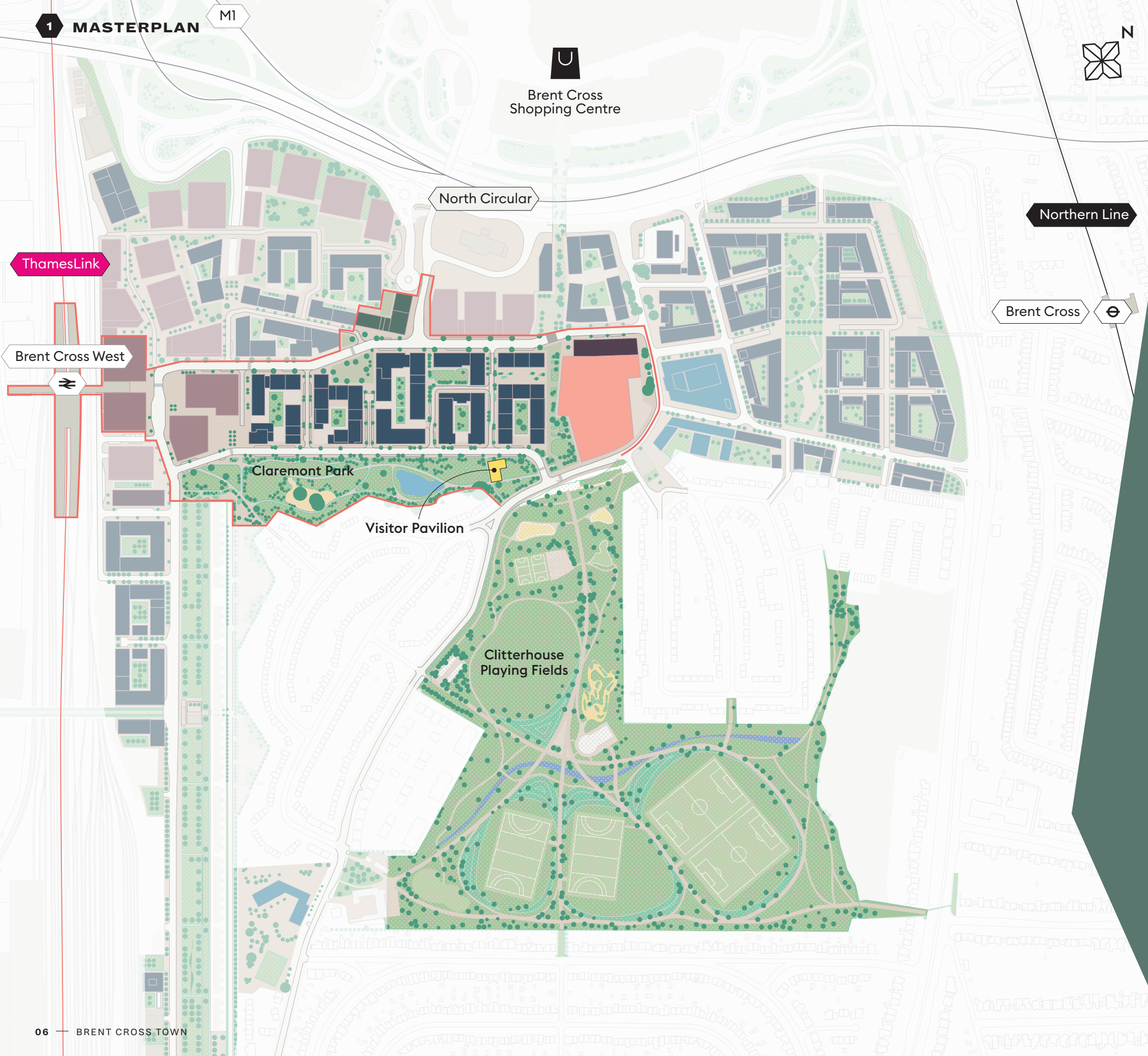

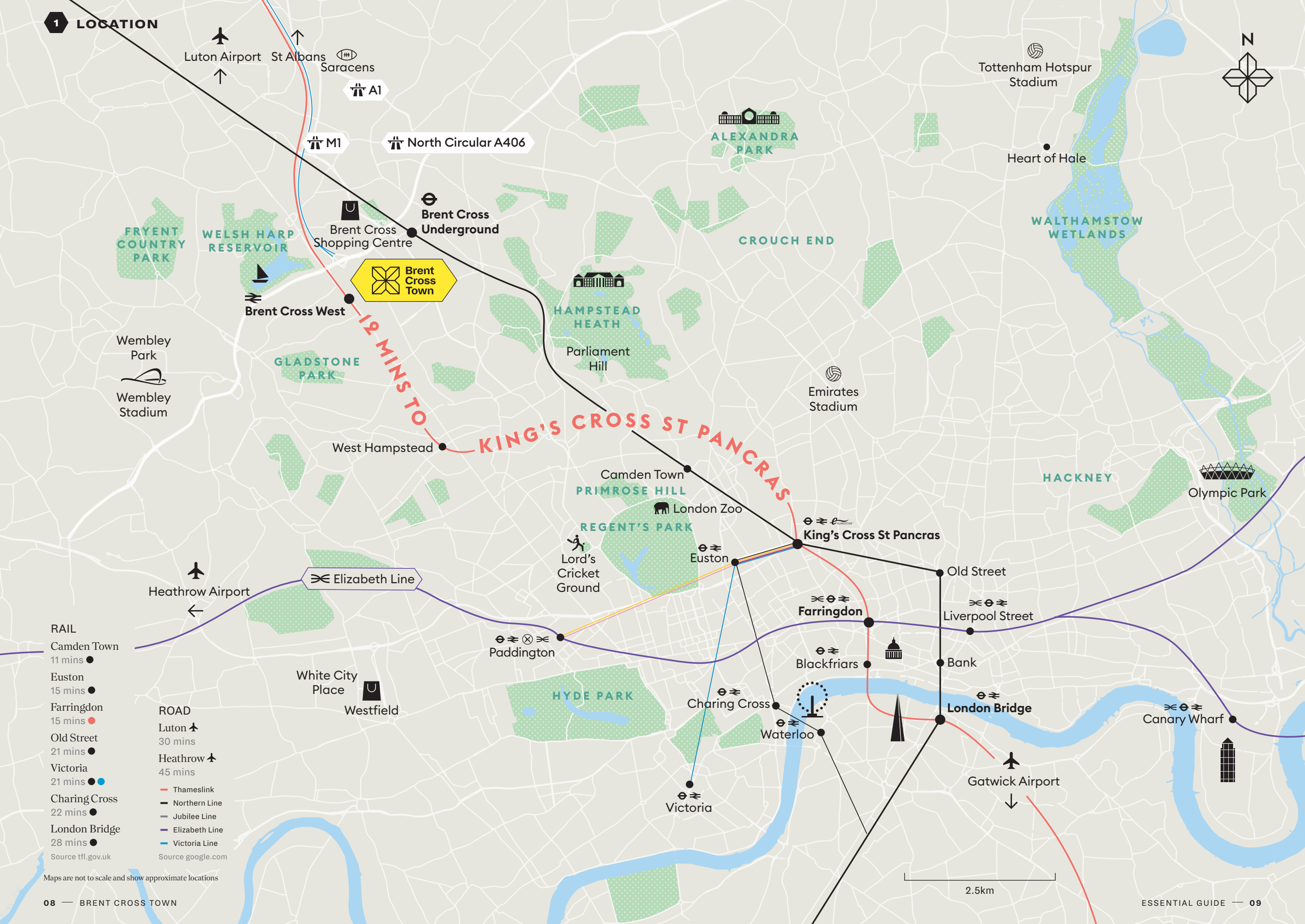

A plan for the FUTURE

Brent Cross Town is the centrepiece of a wider regeneration programme and is one of Europe's largest regeneration projects. This pioneering mixed-use neighbourhood brings together 6,700 new homes, over 50 locations for retail, food and drink, office space for over 25,000 workers, three improved schools, new sports and wellness amenities and expansive green spaces for all.

Set over 50 acres of parks and playing fields and with up to 150,000 sq ft of indoor facilities, our unrivalled multi-sport and play destination puts health, fitness and well-being at the very heart of the town.

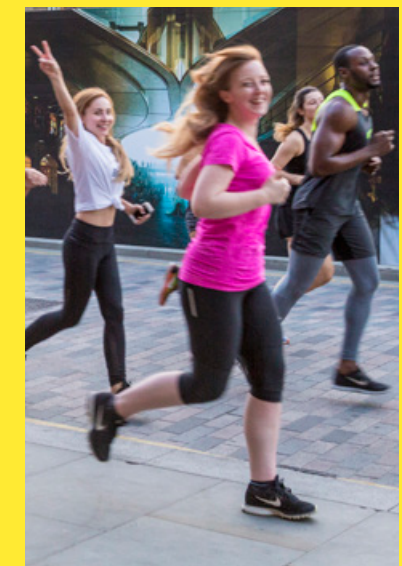
Our sports and play facilities will span age and cultural barriers, as well as ensuring women and girls feel included through our partnership with WOMEN in SPORT and the implementation of their guidance and best practice.

People will enjoy traditional sports like football, hockey and netball; challenger sports such as skateboarding, BMX and parkour; and social sports that include pickleball, teqball, table tennis and boule. There will also be outdoor gyms, weekly park runs and lots of open spaces to relax and just play.

PLEDGE 2: A Flourishing Community. We're putting, CONVENIENCE, NEIGHBOURLINESS, INCLUSIVITY, and GOOD HEALTH at the heart of our FLOURISHING COMMUNITY.

People enjoy a better quality of life and greater sense of community when all everyday necessities are easily accessible on foot or by bicycle.

In our new town everything will be accessible within 15 mins providing residents and workers with easy access to shops, restaurants, schools, childcare, healthcare and work. This is not only convenient, but also creates a familiarity with other people in the community, a stronger sense of togetherness and pride in where they live.

Brent Cross Town is the first to develop and use a Flourishing Index which measures community and individual wellbeing from the outset of the development through to completion.

In partnership with Buro Happold and University of Manchester we'll measure a range of criteria so that we can understand how our communities are developing and be able to adapt our future plans accordingly.

We will make a NORTH LONDON town where all can FLOURISH.

BXT. Why is it important somewhere sounds great?

JJ. Sound and music have the ability to bring joy and according to the World Health Organisation can reduce stress, improve mood and help us learn new things.

BXT. How do you create a town's sound?

JJ. We create a holistic Sound and Music Strategy, which puts the town's sounds alongside how it looks, creating a positive space that people want to be in.

BXT. Is this a new idea?

JJ. Brent Cross Town will be the first town in the UK specifically designed to embrace the positive effects of sound.

BXT. What will Brent Cross Town sound like?

JJ. There will be spaces for music performances, instruments in the playgrounds and 'safe sounds', which we may only be aware of subconsciously, such as white noise, birdsong and sweeping soundscapes.

BXT. How is this possible?

JJ. We now have the technology to be much more sophisticated about the use of sound and music and can zone sounds to complement and enhance surroundings.

PLEDGE 3: We will be a NET ZERO CARBON TOWN BY 2030 — addressing the GLOBAL CHALLENGE of the climate crisis.

We have committed to a net zero carbon town by 2030, at the latest.

- Neighbourhood-wide district energy network created with Vattenfall, the leader in city-scale green energy infrastructure, provides zero carbon heating to all buildings.
- 100% renewable energy for all energy supplies controlled by Brent Cross Town.
- Thoughtful design of energy efficient buildings to reduce operational energy demand.
- 40% reduction in embodied carbon compared with standard current practice.
- 6,600 cycle spaces, 2.75 km of new cycling routes, and a pedestrian and cyclist friendly network of new streets which will be low-speed.

VATTENFALL

We are proud to work with Vattenfall, the largest operator of heat networks in Western Europe, and already supplying more than two million customers. Vattenfall will operate the neighbourhood's energy services company and our partnership will drive our ambition towards net zero carbon at Brent Cross Town.

We are making every effort to minimise our carbon emissions during construction and will offset where unavoidable.

Brent Cross West will provide excellent transport links into Central London and the Knowledge Quarter around King's Cross, as well as out to the academic heartlands of the Oxford-Cambridge Arc.

We will also be enhancing connections throughout the wider local area via a network of new and improved cycle and walking routes.

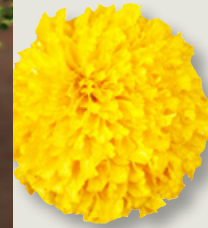


With 50 acres of accessible parks and playing fields, residents, workers and visitors can enjoy all the physical and emotional benefits of an outdoor lifestyle.

Open spaces will deliver five distinct habitats: woodland, grassland, wetland, 'open mosaic' and food growing areas. As well as urban nature trails, strategic tree planting and year-round sensory planting.

The planting of native trees and shrubs will connect animals, birds and insects with the surrounding habitats like the Welsh Harp Reservoir and Hampstead Heath.

A network of new streets, paths and routes provide the ideal way to enjoy the calming outdoor and natural spaces whether cycling, running or just taking a stroll.

A business community where **QUALITY OF LIFE** is central to the future of work.

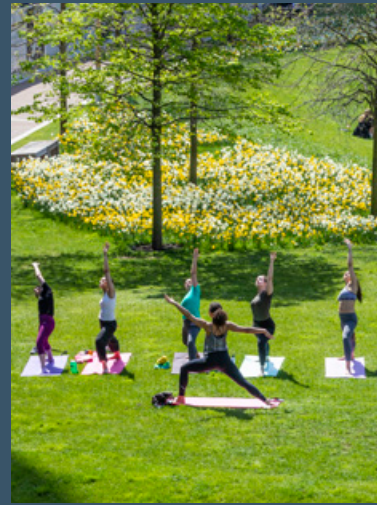
Our pioneering office space with the flexibility to change to evolving ways of working, will establish a thriving new business community for 25,000 workers.

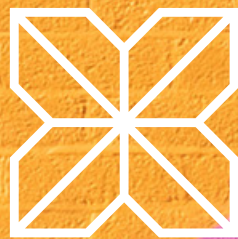
